Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries:

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and **two** of his Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

TEAM CLASS - Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner.

AKC Definitions

Definitions are from the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 3, Dog Show Classifications.

NOVICE:

SECTION 7. The Novice Class shall be for dogs six months of age and over, which have not, prior to the date of closing of entries, won three first prizes in the Novice Class, a first prize in Amateur Owner Handler, Bred-by-Exhibitor, American-bred, or Open Classes, nor one or more points toward their championships.

AMERICAN BRED:

SECTION 9. The American-bred Class shall be for all dogs (except champions) six months of age and over, whelped in the United States of America, by reason of a mating which took place in the United States of America.

NON-REGULAR COMPETITIVE CLASSES:

RULES CH 3, SECTION 13 Non-regular classes involving single dog entries such as Veterans or Field Trial classes are judged before Best of Breed. The winner of the class, if otherwise undefeated, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed. A champion may occasionally be entered both in a single dog entry non-regular class and Best of Breed. In such cases, if the dog is defeated in the non-regular class, it may not compete for Best of Breed or for Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

Each of the Challenge Trophies is offered through the PVIWC for competition at its Specialty Shows only. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the exact same owner (or breeder, for those awarded to the winning dog's breeder), not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows. These Challenge Trophies are to be held by the Club until the next Specialty Show. A memento (indicated by *) may be awarded to these challenge trophy winners to commemorate their win.



CARDIAC TESTING-IWF Life Cycle Study & OFA Certification The Irish Wolfhound Foundation will sponsor heart screening with Dr. William Tyrrell, DACVIM (Cardiology) on Sunday March 31, 2019.

Owners will pay \$175 per hound (\$100 for hounds over 8 years old) for echocardiogram with electrocardiogram (EKG) or \$60 for auscultation and EKG. The balance of the cost is covered by the IWF. Entry is limited and preregistration is advised.
